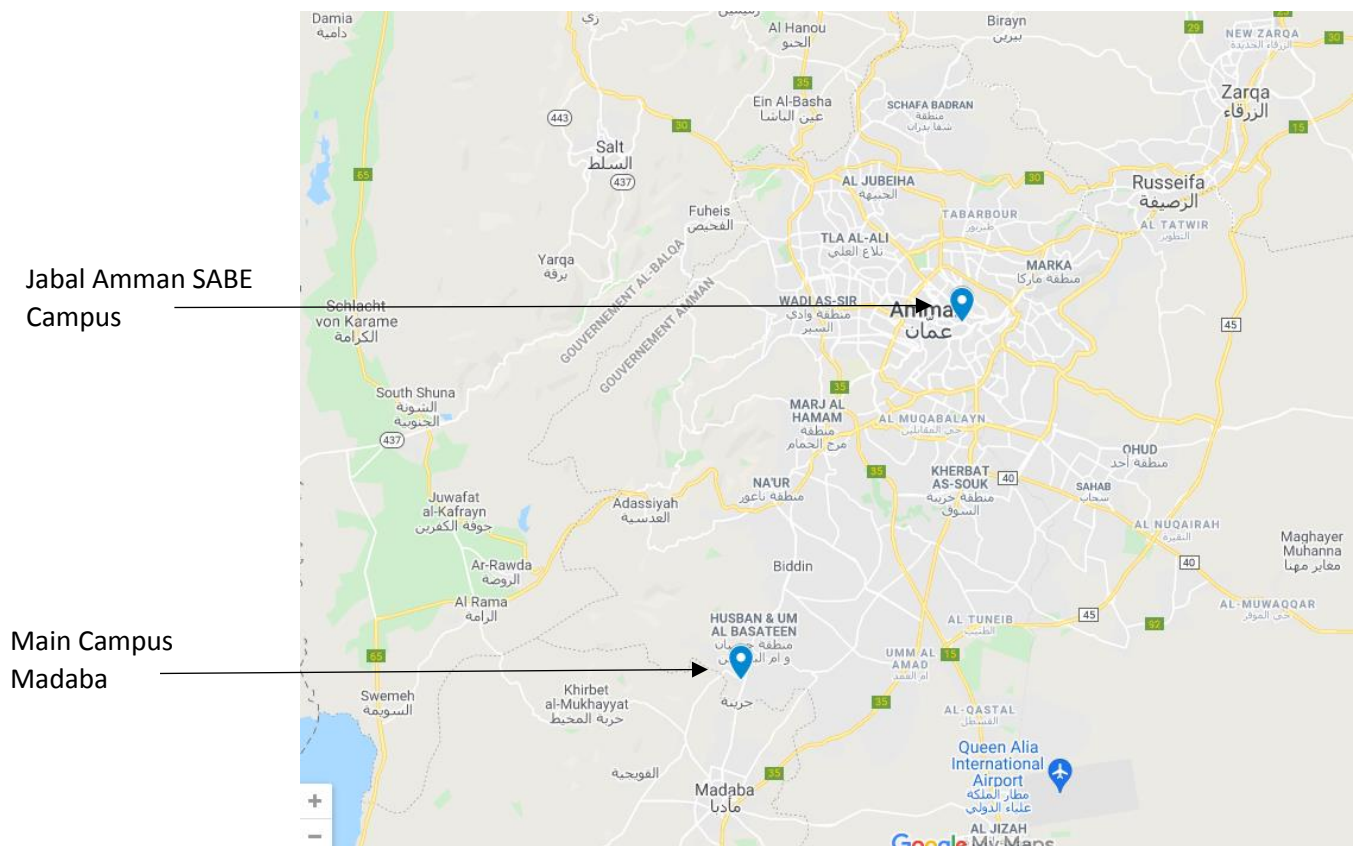


Accommodation and ways to campus

Two campuses

The GJU has two campuses, one on the road to Madaba (Main Campus) and one in Jabal Amman (SABE Campus). In Jabal Amman, all courses of the School of Architecture and Built Environment (SABE) take place, plus the majority of Social Work and other Master courses. Please inquire beforehand, on which campus your lectures will take place.



Where to live?

Lecturers and guests at GJU should decide whether they would like to be accommodated in Amman or in Madaba. When teaching at SABE Campus, living in Amman is the most convenient way. When teaching at the Main Campus in Madaba, both places are an option. Amman is a lively, big city with many things to offer, but it will take around 45 min to reach the Main Campus.

Madaba is an old town, calm and less expensive, it takes approx. 10 min to reach the Main Campus. The decision where to live lies completely with the guests, who are also in charge of booking the accommodation by themselves. We recommend to use a regular online reservation portal, such as booking.com, agoda.com, kayak.com to make use of their cancellation policy, in case the journey cannot take place as planned.

Here are some accommodations guests of GJU have used so far:

Hotels in Amman:

- Jabal Amman Heritage House (end of Rainbow Street in Jabal Amman, approx. 65 JOD/night)
- New MerryLand Hotel (at the end of Al Webdeh, approx. 40 JOD/night)
- Canary Boutique Hotel (in Al Webdeh, approx. 50 JOD/night)
- Sydney Hotel (very close to SABE Campus and downtown, has a kitchen, approx. 20 JOD/night)
- Toledo Amman Hotel (at the beginning of Jabal Al Hussein, approx. 50 JOD/night)
- Shams Al Webdeh Hotel Suites (in the middle of Al Webdeh, approx. 60 JOD/night)
- Dali House (Apartments in the middle of Al Webdeh, has a kitchen, approx. 20 JOD/night)
- Geneva Hotel (at 7th circle, approx. 60 JOD/night)
- There are many 5 star hotel chains in Amman, like Crowne Plaza, Mövenpick, Fairmont, etc.
- AirBnB is also an option to have a more individual accommodation away from hotels

Hostels in Amman:

- Carob Hostel (really nice and authentic hostel in Jabal Al Hussein, approx. 12 JOD/night)
- The Wanderers Hostel (Hostel at 2nd circle, run by former GJU students, approx. 20 JOD/night)

Hotels in Madaba:

- Grand Hotel Madaba (5 min walking from Madaba city centre, approx. 60 JOD/night)
- Mosaic City Hotel (in Madaba city centre, approx. 50 JOD/night)
- Salome Hotel (5 min walking from Madaba city centre, approx. 30 JOD/night)
- Mariam Hotel (5 min walking from Madaba city centre, approx. 40 JOD/night)
- Furnished apartments for short term rent (300 JOD/two weeks, 165/one week, please contact Ayed: Whatsapp: +36 20 520 3540)

How to get to campus

SABE Campus Jabal Amman

We highly recommend to book an accommodation in the surrounding, so you can walk to the campus. All accommodation in Jabal Amman, Al Webdeh and Al Hussein are within walking distance to the campus, although it can be hilly and walks might take longer than expected. Otherwise, taxis and Uber are always an option.

Main Campus Madaba

To reach the Main Campus from Amman, there are several possibilities: Staff buses for GJU employees are running (but only in the morning and afternoon), one leaves from Downtown Amman. Please inquire within the International Affairs Department at GJU to use those. There are also student buses going from different areas in Amman to the Main campus at several times during the day, the International Affairs Department will help you. There is also a public bus (line 1035) leaving from 7th circle in Amman every hour for 0,6 JD. We will assist you in finding that bus the first time.

You can always take a taxi to get to Madaba, but the drivers might refuse to turn on the meter and want a set price. From Amman center it should not be more than 10-12 JOD one way. Uber and Kareem are also an option, both work via an app.

There is also the possibility of hiring a private driver, we listed some known contacts below. For 10-15 JOD they should bring you one way to the Main Campus from Amman. Having a private driver also has the advantage of being able to visit some sites after work, like Mount Nebo or the Dead Sea, for example.

From Madaba city, there are two options to get to the Main Campus: The cheapest and most authentic one is to take a public bus (0,5 JOD one way) somewhere at the Madaba Al-Gharbi Street. There are no fixed times or fixed stops. The public buses are white and there is a lettering above the headlights (as a differentiation aid). If they can take you, they will signal this via headlight flasher. The ride normally takes between 10 to 20 min., but be sure to plan time to wait for the bus (normally 15 min).

Another option is to take a taxi or an Uber. Normally, one way should not cost more than 3-4 JOD. This is also the quickest way (max. 10 min).
