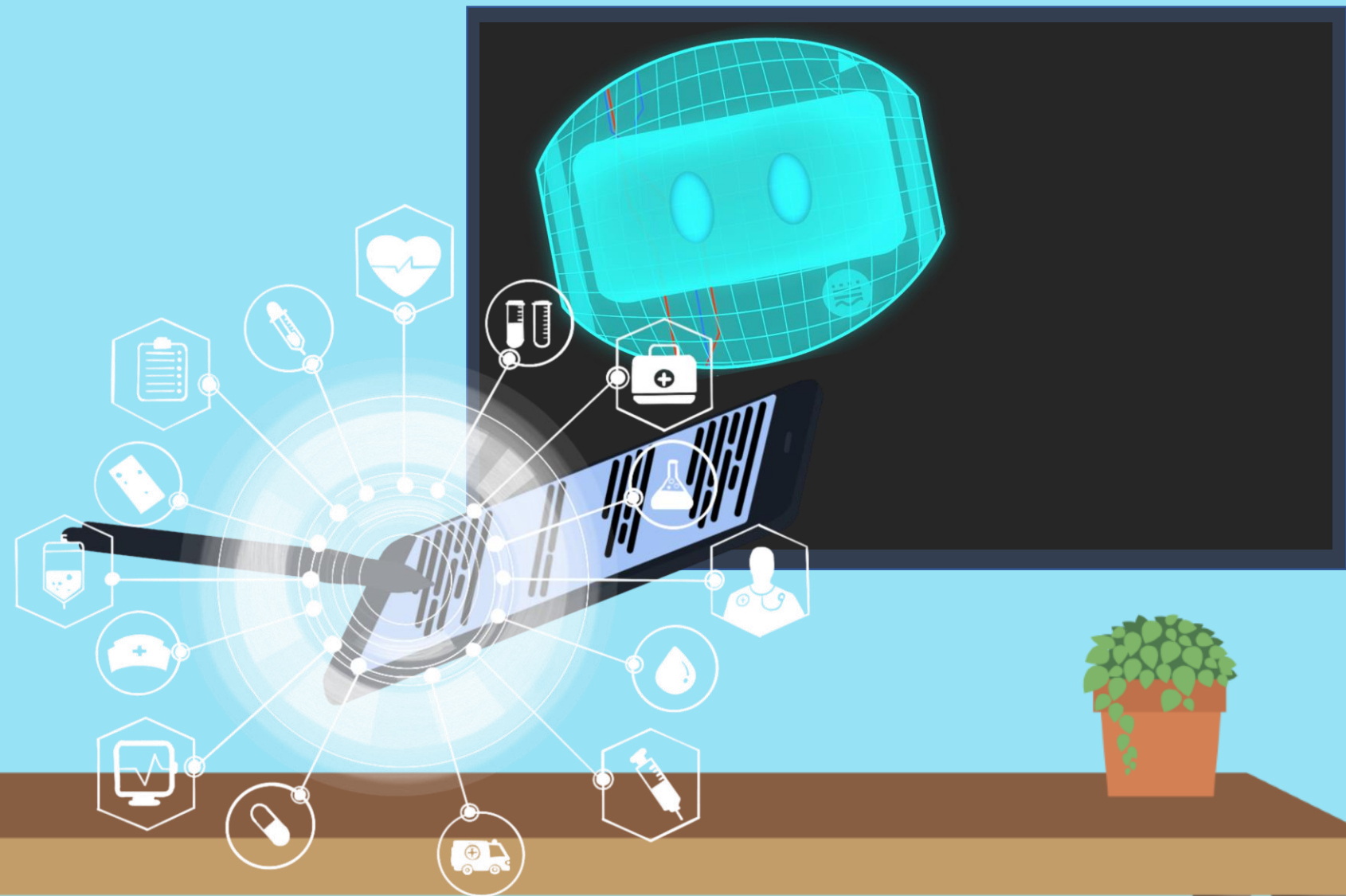


Bachelor Applied Computer Science

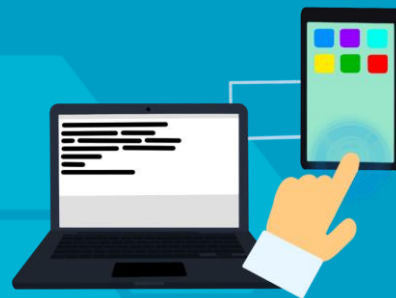

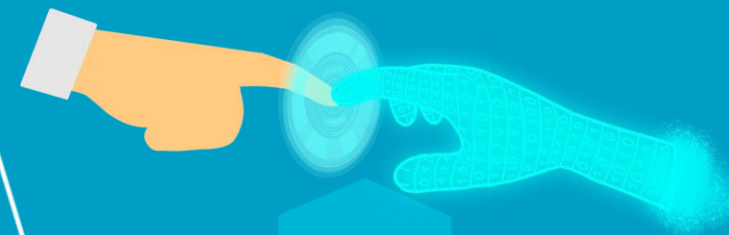

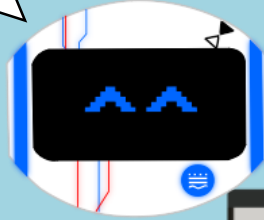
