### **Main responsibilities:**

- Communicating with 3PL providers to manage and control the stock within two different locations (USA, and Dubai).
- Prepare and send ASN's (Advance Shipment Notice) to organize inbound deliveries.
- Follow up and track local orders within the USA until the receipt of goods, in addition to report any delays or wrong destination shipments to the logistics manager.
- Check and control all inbounds for different methods of stocking.
- Verify, and solve any discrepancies after confirming the receiving of goods in the warehouse and report it directly to the logistics manager as well as damages or defects if any.
- Manage cycle counts; producing final results as well as stock adjustments and justifications for inventory at the SKU level.
- Control, check and confirm all outbound deliveries for AMCAN's shipments.
- Sometimes producing final invoices for outbound deliveries.
- Manage transfers between two warehouses as needed.
- Participate in forecasting and demand planning with top management.
- Providing reports as needed.

- Invoice matching, and cost confirmation.
- Tracking local orders received from suppliers on a daily basis.
- Confirm the daily Manual Stock Transactions (MSTs), to adjust the warehouse stock.
- Control reject sales report at stores and fix the discrepancies.
- Confirm returns from stores to the warehouse.
- Investigate and confirm short deliveries.
- To prevent any causes that will increase the shrink percentage.
