

## **Network meeting with School of Architecture and Built Environment held in Wiesbaden**

On Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> and Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> of April, Exchange coordinator Rejan Ashour, Exchange officer Amal Dahmous and Network coordinator Stefanie Kirsch represented GJU's School of Architecture and Built Environment (SABE) at Hochschule RheinMain in Wiesbaden. The network meeting was hosted by the network heads Prof. Christine Bernhard (HS RheinMain) and Prof. Dagmar Eisermann (HS Koblenz) inviting ten German professors from different partner universities for workshops and discussions.

Prof. Christine Bernhard gave an overview about the history of the German-Jordanian network outlining the milestones in establishing the network during the past ten years.

The topics of the agenda range from Erasmus Plus and Erasmus Transformation partnerships to matching new BA/MA programs within the partnership and the expansion of the network for the Design Department as the number of students are rising and more seats for the exchange with German host universities are required.

A Dictionary of Terminology (Fachsprache) in German, English and Arabic is being established together with the Fachsprache Coordinators at each GJU school and updated with every Flying Faculty professor visiting GJU provided that students will have free access to it via their school websites.

The network meeting was additionally enriched by the opportunity to attend the renowned [SEE-Conference](#) and to visit [Scholz & Volkmer](#) - the biggest advertising agency in Wiesbaden, where several speakers of the conference also presented their ideas in workshops and discussions.

After many fruitful discussions lead to an action plan that should be implemented until next network meeting Prof. Christine Bernhard was reelected as network head for Design Network while Prof. Dagmar Eisermann from Hochschule Koblenz was elected to be the new Network head for Architecture.
