This is to inform you that GJU will offer a new *adapt2Job-2win-Training* workshop supported by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and organized by the Office for Industrial Links (OIL) in cooperation with the School of Applied Technical Sciences (SATS).

The workshop targets GJU students (3rd year and above) from several disciplines (mainly from Industrial Eng., Mechatronics, Mechanical and Maintenance Eng., Computer Science and Engineering, Communications Eng., Pharmaceutical & Chemical Biomedical Eng.; Energy, Water& Environmental Engineering, Management, Logistics and Accounting, School of Languages and Architecture/Design). It will be held at GJU campus from **September 23rd to September 27th, 2018.**

In its current round, an emphasis is put on concrete business opportunities in Jordan, the region and the International market. **The workshop comprises training and in-depth-work that aim at developing business models, how digitalization 2018 and beyond can lead to new businesses, jobs and internships in Jordan, the region and the international market.** You will work in groups on your project and you will present your work to the Evaluation Council as a proposal on how your Digital Products and Services can be applied in Jordan. Your results and your employability will be evaluated jointly by industry representatives of the different sectors and the adapt2Job Team.

Only motivated and committed students (20-30) will be selected. Interested students are required to send their CVs and motivation letters to Mrs. Britta Kaehler, Director of the Office for Industrial Links (Britta.Kaehler@gju.edu.jo) no later than **September 12th, 2018.**

The participated students will get a chance of being in touch with international and local industrial representative experts to establish their own network, find internships and suitable jobs. At the end of the workshop, the students will be awarded a prestigious Certificate.
