German Jordanian University announces the start of receiving applications for admission to the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene MSc program offered for the first semester of the academic year 2024/2025, as follows.

Application Period	From Sunday, June 30, 2024, until the end of Saturday, September 14, 2024.
Start of Studying	The first semester will start on October 6 th , 2024.
General Admission Requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Bachelor's degree with a grade not less than "Good."2. Proof of English language proficiency (TOEFL IBT or IELTS).3. Passing a personal interview.

Mechanism for paying the admission application fees	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Pay the application fees (25 JD non-refundable).2. Payment is only available on the payment service (Efawatercom) from inside and outside Jordan. Required Documents for Admission	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A scanned copy of your Identification Card (for Jordanians) or a scanned copy of your passport (for non-Jordanians). 2. A scanned copy of your High School Certificate. For non-Jordanians, a scanned copy of the High School Equivalency Certificate issued by the Jordanian Ministry of Education. 3. A scanned copy of your bachelor’s degree certificate and transcripts, and any other degrees (if applicable). 4. . A copy of experience certificates and training courses, if any 5. A recent copy of the CV. 6. A written approval issued by the authorized authority stating that the holder has no objection to studying for the Jordanian Ministry of Education for the applicants from the Armed force and security apparatus. 7. A copy of the social security statement for the majors requires practical experience. 8. A scanned copy of your English Language proficiency exam result IETLS or TOEFL – less than two years old. 9. The applicant must have a score approved by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in one of the English language exams, as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. iBT exam from one of the centers accredited by the AMIDEAST Center / Jordan or from the accredited centers in the country in which the student resides, provided that the applicant brings a document that the center is accredited there, and the accredited centers in Jordan.

2. IELTS exam from UniHouse-for Consultations and Studies, Oval International Academy, or British Council, or from the approved centers in the country in which the student resides, provided that a document is presented that the center is accredited there, and the approved centers in Jordan (note that the university provides the possibility of holding the IELTS exam in cooperation with the British Council :

Documents required upon admission

1. Bring all documents in paper, duly certified and authenticated.
2. An estimate for the rating (Grade Point Average, GPA) from Jordan Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research for graduates of foreign universities or universities for which there is no estimate of the rating.
3. A copy of the certificate equivalency from the Jordanian Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research for graduates of non-Jordanian universities (For Jordanians only).

Requirement for WaSH MSc program

- Be a holder of an undergraduate degree in any field of study from a recognized university with a minimum average of “Good” in one of the following programs:
 - Water and/or sanitation management
 - Public Health (hygiene promotion, behavior change, social work)
 - Hydraulics
 - Hydrogeology
 - Epidemiology, Agronomy, Chemistry, Civil Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Environmental Engineering or Environment Science.
- Passing the English proficiency Exam.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passing the personal interview if required. • Recommendation letter from a party operating in the field of the Master program. • Motivation letter • Professional experience in NGO or private sector related to Water, sanitation, and/or public health (Preferred) • Credit hour fee; JD 185/ credit hour • Credit hours number: 33credit hours • Track: Thesis. • Studying will be at GJU campus in Jabal Amman, Amman. • Lectures will be daily, starting at 5:00 PM and finishing at 8:00 PM, from Saturday to Thursday. Some Saturdays will be fully occupied. • The applicant’s university should be accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education in Jordan, check via this link: http://rce.mohe.gov.jo/en/RecognizedUniversities
