

Dear outgoing students,

I am more than glad to inform you that our partner HS Magdeburg-Stendal has received additional funding by the DAAD to provide scholarships for outgoing students starting their German Year in the 1st academic semester 2024/2025.

This support measure is exclusively for GJU German Year students going to Germany 1st semester 2024/25 and has the aim to further strengthen the cooperation within the academia in Germany and to support students to find a suitable internship. There is no need to apply for the scholarships. Students receiving any other scholarship in the 1st semester 2024/2025 are non-eligible. All other outgoing students are eligible to receive the scholarship announced here.

The following regulations apply in order to benefit from the scholarship:

- 1) Only students traveled to Germany and are still studying and living there are eligible.
- 2) Attendance at events at the career service at the German partner university is mandatory until you found an internship. IAD will report to the PO at HS Magdeburg-Stendal.
- 3) Attendance of the IAD online format “feedback session” (2 per semester) is mandatory. IAD will report to the PO at HS Magdeburg-Stendal.
- 4) Adherence to ethical standards not only as representatives of GJU and Jordan but also as described in the signed Code of Conduct.

Please note that nonadherence to these regulations might result in cancellation of the scholarship from the side of the PO at Magdeburg-Stendal and the obligation to pay it fully or partially back.

We expect that the financial support and the measures explained above will substantially add to the unique experience of your German Year and strengthen the German Dimension of GJU.

It is planned to financially support the stay in Germany as follows:

641 Euro monthly for 6 months

The total amount of 3846 Euro is planned to be transferred from the Project Office at HS Magdeburg-Stendal to your German bank account.

According to the conditions of the funding, the financial support is exclusively for the outgoing student's 1st semester 2024/2025. Unfortunately, it is not possible to fund your 2nd semester in Germany.

Please note that this information is legally non-binding. The distribution of the scholarships and the amount to be awarded depends on final approval of the grant application of Hochschule Magdeburg-Stendal by the relevant authorities. We will keep you updated.
