The 1st German Jordanian Future University Conference at GJU brings together German and Jordanian university members to work on the following questions and alike:

- Will students be able to customize their educational programs across different universities?
- What legal conditions, structures, equipment, processes, networks, standards, and capabilities are required?

Pioneers of the reform in Germany are providing impetus. University representatives from Jordan and Germany will present existing and planned reform measures at their universities. Workshops will explore individual issues in greater depth. The results will be summarized in a resolution following the conference.
