

Comprehensive Training Course in Vision Rehabilitation

This course aims at improving the knowledge and skills of professionals in the field of vision rehabilitation. This comprehensive course is formed by a series of lectures delivered by GJU lecturers and clinicians who combine theoretical lectures with hands-on activities.

The program focus on two main areas:

1. Rehabilitation for People with Low Vision. The topics covered comprise: low vision assessment, magnification, optical devices and visual skill training.
2. Education and Rehabilitation of People with Visual Impairment. The course content includes: early intervention, education, orientation and mobility and independent skills.

Objectives:

Through theoretical classes, practical work and case studies, the participants learn to:

1. Identify, assess and plan appropriate intervention for people with visual disability.
2. Promote the development and participation in activities of daily life of people with visual disability.
3. Work in multidisciplinary teams to provide services in a variety of settings.

Programme Structure:

Full time study programme with weekly lectures concentrated on three days (Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays, 2 to 5pm) and practical work (2 hrs/week).

Languages of Instruction:

Lectures, seminars and practical work are in English with simultaneous Arabic translation or vice versa.

Admission Requirements:

Candidates should be holders of a University degree in education, rehabilitation sciences, optometry, nursing or other disciplines relevant to vision rehabilitation.

Application deadlines:

Inside Jordan: before the start of the training course.

Outside Jordan: Foreigner students should contact us 1 month in advance at least before the beginning of the training course to complete their visa procedure.

The course will start on Sunday 14th of November 2021 and end on Sunday 30th of January 2022.
