

Professional Diploma in Vision Rehabilitation

This course aims at improving the knowledge and skills of professionals in the field of vision rehabilitation. The diploma is formed by a series of lectures delivered by renowned European experts who combine theoretical lectures with hands-on activities. The participants have the opportunity to choose between two tracts:

Profile A: Education and Rehabilitation of People with Visual Impairment. The course content includes: early intervention, education, orientation and mobility and independent skills.

Profile B: Rehabilitation for People with Low Vision. The topics covered comprise: low vision assessment, magnification, optical devices and visual skill training.

Objectives:

Through theoretical classes, practical work and case studies, the participants learn to:

1. Identify, assess and plan appropriate intervention for people with visual disability.
2. Promote the development and participation in activities of daily life of people with visual disability.
3. Work in multidisciplinary teams to provide services in a variety of settings.

Programme Structure:

Full time study programme with weekly lectures concentrated on three days (Saturdays, Mondays and Wednesdays, 14:30 to 18:30) and practical work (2 hrs a week).

Tuition Fees and Other Fees: 700 JDs

Languages of Instruction:

Lectures, seminars and practical work are in English with simultaneous Arabic translation or vice versa.

Admission Requirements:

Candidates should be holders of a University degree in education, rehabilitation sciences, optometry, nursing or other disciplines relevant to vision rehabilitation.

Application deadline is 1st August 2016. The programme will start on Saturday 1st of October 2016 and end on the 15th of January 2017.

Practical Training in Vision Rehabilitation
