<p style="text-align: center;">English Language Preparatory Program</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The preparatory program is a course designed for applicants who do not possess internationally recognized English language proficiency certificates (TOEFL iBT or IELTS) to meet the admission requirements. - This program will be offered in the First Semester 2026/2027, according to the following conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Lectures are held physically (on campus), twice a week (on Saturdays), for a total of six (6) credit hours. 2. Candidate evaluation is based on a comprehensive assessment system, whereby each course has only one exam with a total score of 120 points. This exam is administered twice during the semester, and the higher score is recorded. 3. The exam assesses the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. 4. Passing grades are determined according to the field of specialization as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Humanities, Economics, and Administrative fields: 60% or higher. b) Sciences, Nursing, Rehabilitation Sciences, and Business Administration fields: 78% or higher. c) Engineering fields: 90% or higher.
<p style="text-align: center;">Exemption from the English Language Proficiency Requirement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Graduate students who have already fulfilled the English Language Proficiency during their enrollment in master's programs, whether by passing the required English Proficiency Test or by attending & passing the English Language Preparatory Program of 6 Credit Hours. - Students with Bachelor's Degrees from English speaking countries. - Students with hearing impairments (deaf) or visual impairments (blind) who have obtained an identification card from the Higher Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.
<p style="text-align: center;">German Language Proficiency</p>	<p>Those who apply for Master Program in German as a Foreign Language must provide a TestDaf Test result of B2 from one of the recognized German Language TestDaf centers.</p>

<p>Admission Path</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Accepted applicants with "Good" rating in their Bachelor's Degrees are accepted into the Comprehensive Examination Track. - Accepted applicants with "Very Good" rating or more are automatically accepted into the Comprehensive Examination Track. Transfer to the Thesis Track is possible during the First Academic Year (based on the academic performance), according to Article (16/b) of the Instructions for granting Master's Degrees at the university.
