<p><b>PhD in German for Non-Native Speakers, jointly with the University of Freiburg, Germany</b></p>	<p>School of Applied Humanities &amp; Social Sciences (SAHSS) (06) 429 4700</p>	<p>Prospective students must fulfill the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Bachelor's degree (or equivalent) with a rating of at least "Very Good" (or equivalent) from a recognized university.</li> <li>- Master's degree in German Language (or equivalent postgraduate qualification) with a rating of at least "Very Good" (or equivalent).</li> <li>- The Bachelor and Master studies must be systematic.</li> <li>- The applicant's previous studies must be relevant to the proposed thesis.</li> <li>- Proof of German language proficiency at a minimum level of B2 (4X4X4X4).</li> <li>- Proof of English language proficiency (TOEFL iBT: 90) or (IELTS: 6.5) if the thesis is to be written in English.</li> <li>- Fulfillment of the admission requirements of PH Freiburg (University of Education, Freiburg).</li> <li>- The regulations for doctoral studies at PH Freiburg apply, which also represent the doctoral regulations for the joint program.</li> <li>- The official admission requirements are reviewed by the responsible faculty at PH Freiburg. The Joint Doctoral Program Coordination Committee reviews the applications then sends their recommendations for acceptance or preliminary acceptance to the responsible faculty at PH Freiburg.</li> <li>2. The Acceptance Letter from PH Freiburg, or the preliminary Acceptance Letter if the research proposal (Expose') is still being prepared and approved, is submitted to the responsible faculty at the German Jordanian University.</li> <li>3. The German Jordanian University issues Admission Certificates to the applicants who have received their final Acceptance Letters from PH Freiburg.</li> <li>4. The German Jordanian University issues preliminary Acceptance Letters to applicants who received their preliminary Acceptance Letters from PH Freiburg. During the first year, the applicant works on preparing his/her Thesis Proposal (Expose') and submitting it to PH Freiburg. Upon approval of the Thesis Proposal PH Freiburg, the applicant receives the final Acceptance Letter from both universities.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

<p><b>PhD in Social Work Philosophy, hosted in partnership with the University of Hamburg, Germany</b></p>	<p>School of Applied Humanities &amp; Social Sciences (SAHSS) (06) 429 4700</p>	<p>Prospective students must fulfill the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Regular bachelor's degree (or equivalent) with a minimum rating of "Good" (or equivalent), and a regular master's degree (or equivalent) with a minimum rating of "Good" (or equivalent).</li> <li>- Bachelor's and master's degree in related disciplines to Social Work (Education, Psychology, Sociology, Cultural Studies, Counselling, etc.).</li> <li>- A total of 300 ECTS credits (or equivalent) in disciplines relevant to social work.</li> <li>- German or English language competences (C1 according to the CEFR, the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).</li> <li>- Acceptance of a Research Proposal by the PhD Committee at the University of Hamburg.</li> </ul>
