M.Sc. in Architectural Conservation

Credit Hours: 36 credit hours, Thesis track.

Unique Features:

- Understanding the concepts and philosophies relevant to the conservation of buildings and heritage sites.
- Skills in understanding, interpreting, explaining, analyzing, assessing and implementing various conservation concepts and techniques, as well as in judging the nature of the required interventions.
- Mandatory internship at research institutions, international organizations, and architectural firms specialized in conservation.
- Understanding the structural and material aspects of conservation: building materials, deterioration processes and repair techniques.
- All classes will be conducted at Darat Othman Bdeir Campus in Jabal Amman.

Academic Requirements:

- Students with a high school certificate (scientific stream) and an Undergraduate Degree from a recognized university, with a minimum merit of GOOD, in architecture, interior design, cultural resources management, civil engineering,

archaeology, or spatial and urban planning can enroll in the program. An average of “good” does not necessarily guarantee acceptance in the program.

- Admission interview.
- Portfolio that demonstrates projects undertaken during study and practice.
- C. V. illustrating the applicants' qualifications and experiences.

English Language Requirement:

A minimum TOEFL score of 80 out of 120 on an Internet based test (iBT), or a minimum IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 6.0. Students, however, can register as “Special Students” for one semester at GJU provided that they pass the test before the end of that semester.

Required Documents:

- Official bachelor degree transcript and certificate (2 copies), stamped by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in Jordan
- Certified photocopy of passport
- Certified photocopy of personal identification card (ID) {for Jordanian students only}
- 3 personal photos
- Recommendation letter
- TOEFL / IELTS International results
