ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

The German Jordanian University admits undergraduate students based on certain criteria. Students should obtain the Jordanian General Secondary School Certificate (Tawjihi) or an equivalent, with a minimum average of 80% for Engineering and Architecture majors and 75% for Management Sciences, Logistic Sciences, International Accounting, Computer Science, Translation: German/English/Arabic, German & English for Business & Applied Studies, and Design and Visual Communication.
