CV content

Personal information (name, email, number..)

Experiences (those related to the job you're applying to)

Education (start with the most recent ones)

Skills and Certificates (training, courses, languages...)

References (at least 3)







Tips

- Be honest ALWAYS!
- To whom are you applying?
 - US Vs. German CVs
- Neat, organized, clear and summarized CV
- Use a clear font and colour
 - Example: 11-12 for text and 12-14 for titles & 18 for your name
- Use bullet points







Tips

- Spelling mistakes
- Volunteering work (added skills; i.e Communication Skills, time management... Etc)
- Graduation Project (if related to the field of the company you're applying to)
- Cover Letter
