Program Description

In the year 2014 the European Union launched the Erasmus+ program in order to enhance exchange between members of Higher Education institutions in Europe and the rest of the world. Since then GJU has established several partnerships with distinguished universities all over Europe.

The Erasmus+ program provides GJU **undergraduate students** the opportunity to spend one semester at one of our partner universities listed below. The program supports you with a monthly scholarhship that covers living expenses as well as a travel allowance.

Who can apply?

All GJU undergraduate students can apply to participate in Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility.

All partner universities require proficiency in **English**. Applicants should have completed <u>three full</u> semesters by the start of the mobility.

Which partner universities are available?

University College Odisee, Belgium

With 13.000 students, <u>Odisee</u> is the third largest University College of Applied Sciences (= Hogeschool) in Flanders. Odisee offers bachelor study programmes in 4 Flemish cities: Brussels, Ghent, Aalst and Sint-Niklaas.



Exchange students at Odisee will have the opportunity to take part in an internship (can be recognized at GJU instead of the local Field Training) and are supposed to take a minimum of 2 courses. Find an overview about Odisee's courses offered in English in the attachment of the email.

University of Bologna, Italy

The origins of the <u>University of Bologna</u> go way back, and it is considered to be the oldest university in the Western world. How to apply?

The application needs to include the following documents and has to be submitted to the IO:

- 1) Application form
- 2) Updated CV
- 3) **Letter of intent** in English the letter should state:
 - Why do you want to study at this university?
 - Which internship are you interested in (only for Odisee)?
 - At least three subjects that you would be interested in taking from the academic course offer
 - Which benefits do you expect to gain? What do you want to learn during the semester?
 - Which challenges do you expecxt to face?
- 4) Transcript of Record from the Registration Department

Application deadline is May 10, 2017. Only complete applications (soft copy and hard copy) will be considered.

After the deadline applications will be reviewed by the International Office and SMLS. In case there are more eligible applicants than available seats, suitable candidates will be invited for an interview with a GJU selection committee. The results will be communicated to the candidates in due time.
