Health Insurance	In addition to the obligatory GJU Health Insurance, we recommend our Incoming Students to get a Travel Health Insurance from their own country. Personal Liability Insurance is not required.
Visa for 6 Months	A one-month visa can be purchased on arrival at the airport in Amman for 40 JOD . Later on, it must be extended twice (6 months in total).
Visa for more than 6 Months	<p>For a second semester at GJU: The International Office will help with getting the Residence Permit from the Jordanian Ministry of Interior.</p> <p>For an Internship: The company is responsible for providing a Residence Permit for the period of the internship.</p>
