

Information about German Year Scholarship for undergraduate students (all majors except Translation) at the German Jordanian University

Background of the Scholarship

The German Jordanian University was founded as a bi-national university on behalf of the Ministry of Higher Education and Research Germany and the Ministry of Higher Education & Scientific Research Jordan. The German government provides several funds to support and sustain the development of the GJU. A part of the money is dedicated for scholarships for GJU students. The donors of the scholarships are the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) jointly with the University of Applied Sciences Magdeburg (GJU Project Office Magdeburg).

German Year Scholarship

starting Outgoing Batch First Semester 2017/18:

Funding	Funding is provided for the duration of the German Year; lump sum for travel expenses.
Application	Applying for the scholarship is not possible. Scholarships are allocated among the best students of each major. The number of scholarships per major varies each semester.
Criteria	<p>General GPA of at least 76% (weighted 70%) and marks in German VI (weighted 30%).</p> <p>Students who obtained an official B2 Goethe-Zertifikat before leaving to Germany will have an extra 2% added to the total score of GPA and German mark.</p> <p>Note: Starting from Second Semester 2017/18 the marks of German V and VI will be taken into consideration to make up 30 % of the total score related to the German marks.</p>
Selection	An independent Scholarship Committee is selecting the scholarship holders at the beginning of the 1 st and the 2 nd semester. Depending on the data available, the selection process might continue even if the semester has already started.
Duration	One academic year (the German Year).
Extension	Due to the nature of this scholarship, no extension is possible.
Eligibility	Only students meeting all requirements for leaving to Germany with a minimum GPA of 76% are eligible. German Citizens are excluded and cannot receive funds.

Commitment of the Scholarship holder

The scholarship holder has to sign a declaration of acceptance assuring that he/she will not make use of any funding options provided through other institutions for the duration of the scholarship period. Additionally any changes which might effect the scholarship (like the change of major or the change of the University in Jordan) have to be reported to the International Office immediately. Scholarship holders are expected to act as an example for other students and to represent the vision of their German donor in order to fostering academic and intercultural exchange between Germany and Jordan.
