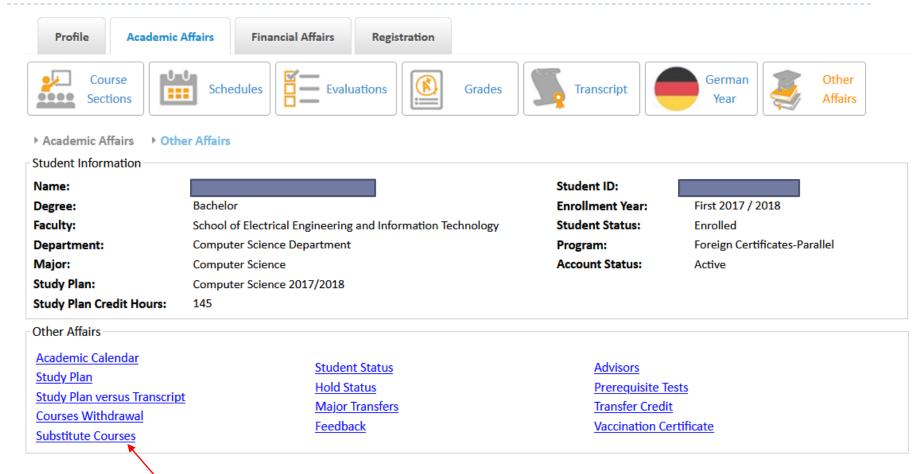


Overview

- Handling a substitute course request by chair, dean(s), and registrar is discussed.



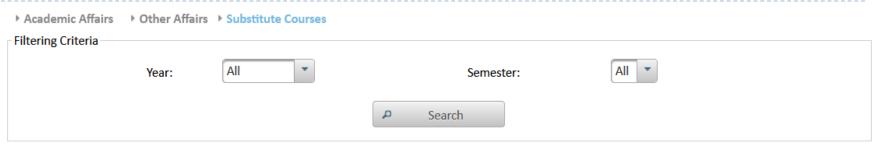
Requesting a Substitute Course by a Student (1)



Login to your MyGJU account, go to Other Affairs, then click the Substitute Courses link



Requesting a Substitute Course by a Student (2)



Note: Your remaining credit hours must be <= 36 to be able to add substitute course requests

Note: Remaining CH = Study Plan CH - (Completed CH on Transcript + Registered CH on Active Semester)

Note: You cannot have more than two not rejected substitute course requests Note: You can only edit and delete requests with pending submission status

Click the Add button to add a request for a substitute course

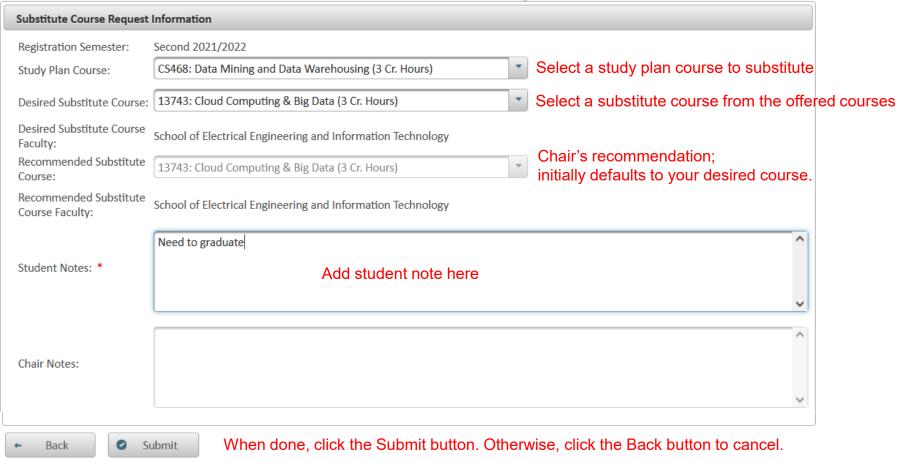
Note: To edit or delete a pending request, select it and then click the edit or delete button, respectively



Requesting a Substitute Course by a Student (3)

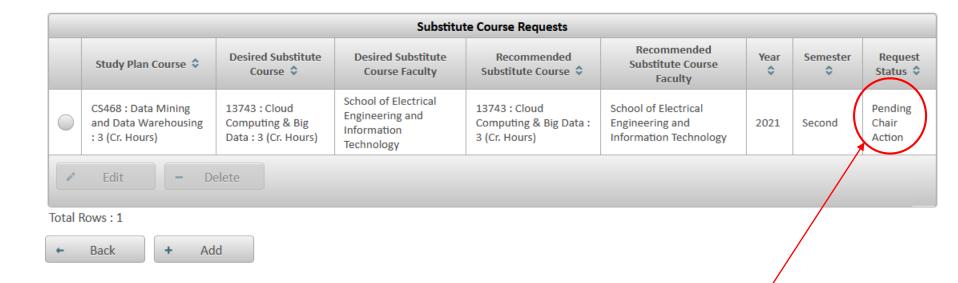
▶ Academic Affairs → Other Affairs → Substitute Courses → Add Substitute Course Request

Requesting a Substitute Course by a Student (4)

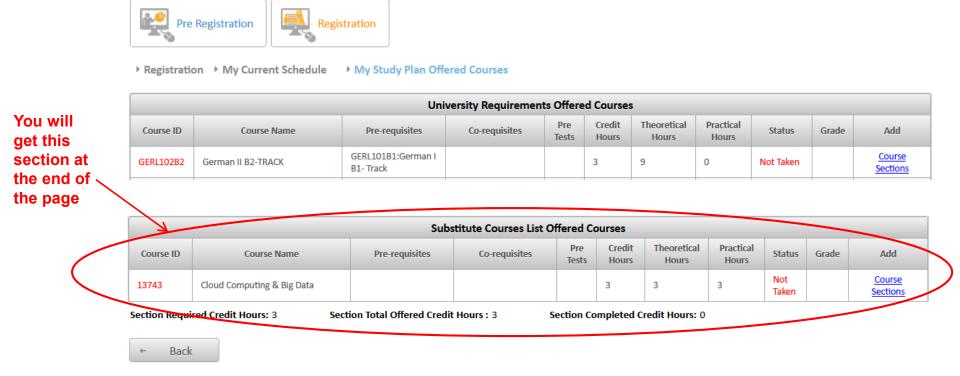


- After submitting the substitute course request in the previous /slide

Once your request is Completed by Registration you will be able to register in that course by yourself when your registration period is active

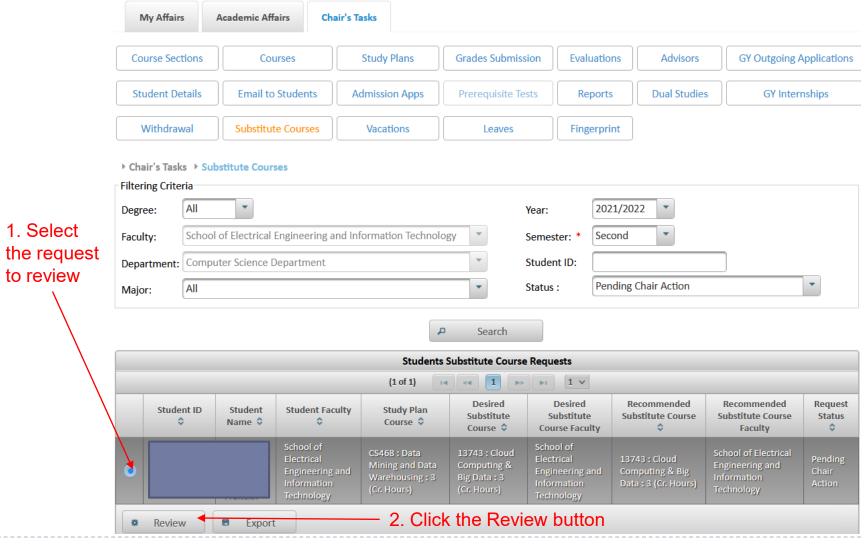

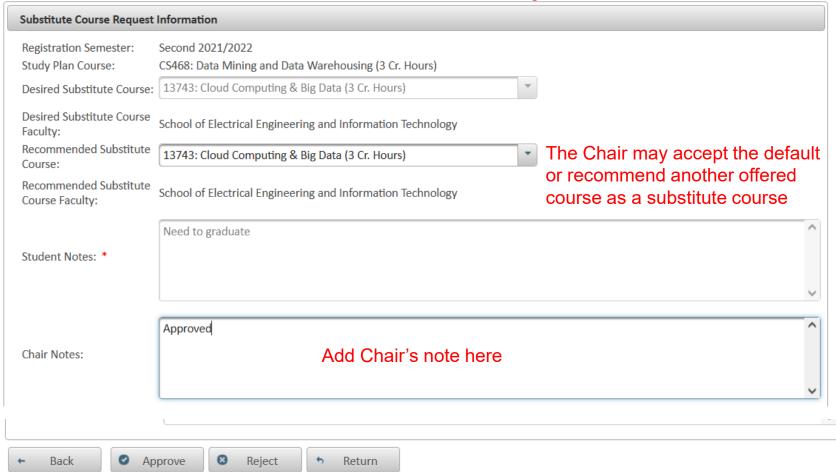

Handling a Substitute Course Request by Chair (2)

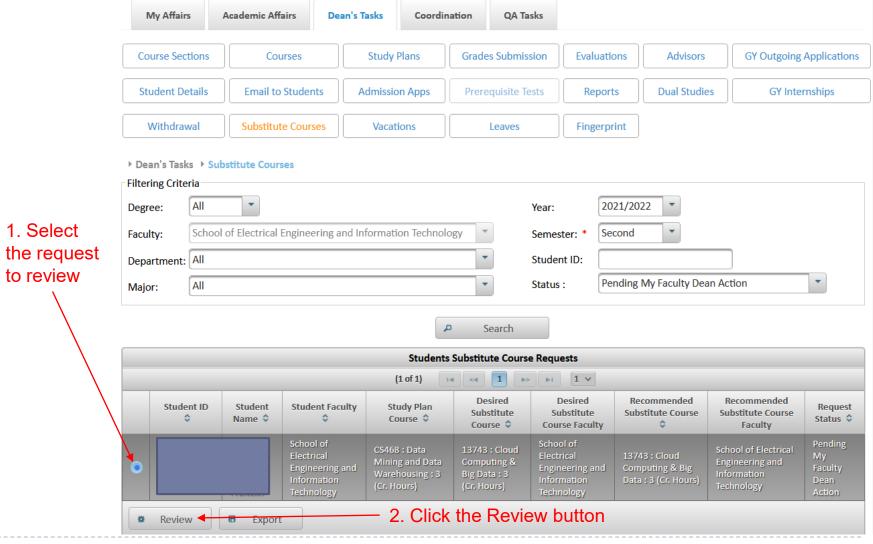
Note: The desired/recommended substitute course lists below contain the offered courses in the active registration semester.

Handling a Substitute Course Request by Dean (1)





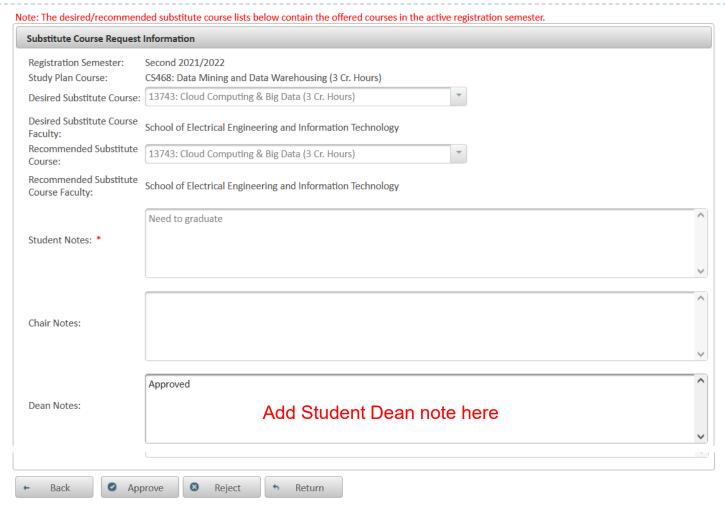
Handling a Substitute Course Request by Dean (2)



A dean has to check the above two statuses to review the substitute course requests that belong to him/her



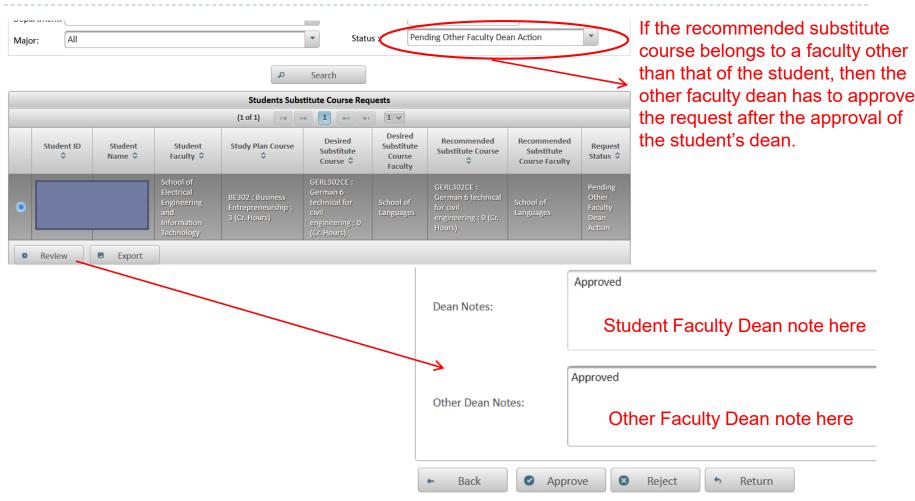
Handling a Substitute Course Request by Dean (3)

Handling a Substitute Course Request by Dean (4)

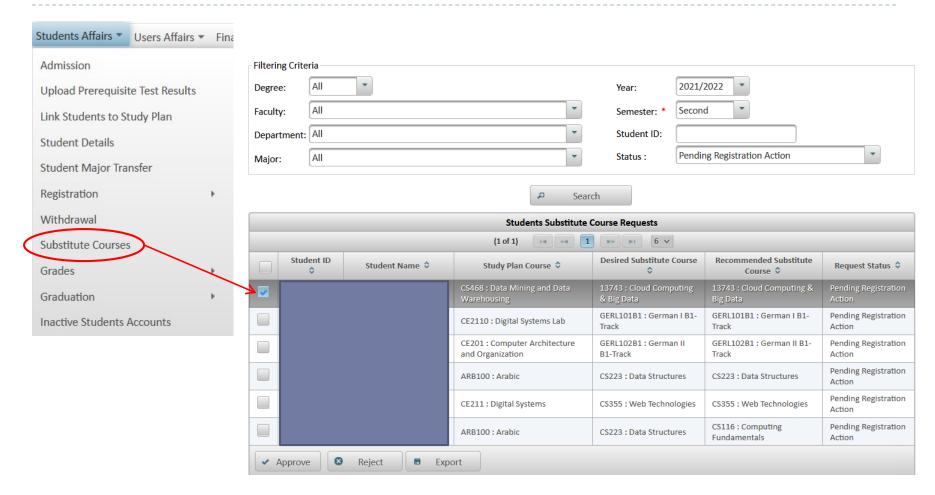


Back: to cancel your changes; **Approve**: to approve the request; **Reject**: to reject the request;

Return: to send the request back to the student for editing or cancellation.



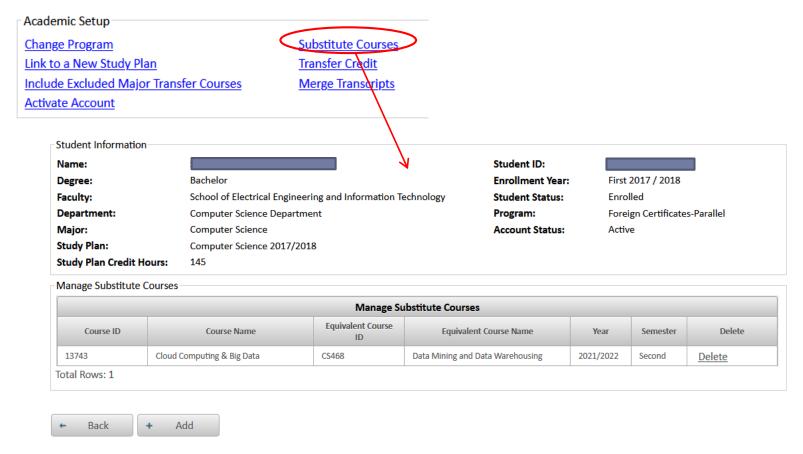
Handling a Substitute Course Request by Registrar (1)



The registrar needs to handle all the substitute courses requests that were approved by deans in order to complete the process and for the requests to be effective.



Handling a Substitute Course Request by Registrar (2)



When a request is approved by the registrar, a record will be added to the student's substitute courses list as shown above...
