

The German Jordanian University Announcement

The Deanship of Graduate Studies at the German Jordanian University announces the start of accepting applications for admission to graduate programs offered for the first semester of the academic year (2023/2024), as follows:

Application period	Starting from Sunday (04/06/2023) until the end of Thursday (31/08/2023).
General conditions of admission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A bachelor's degree and with a no less "good" grade. - Proof of English language ability (TOEFL iBT or IELTS). - Pass the personal interview.
Application mechanism	Via the MyGJU Guests platform at the following link, which contains an explanatory video of the payment mechanism and application submission: https://guests.gju.edu.jo Applications are not accepted after (31/08/2023) and the application and payment mechanism must be adhered to.
The payment of the application fee mechanism	Payment is only available on your payments service (eFAWATEERcom) from inside and outside Jordan. Accordingly, the payment currency is only in Jordanian dinars, and the following explanatory videos can be used: 1. https://youtu.be/I701K7SpQSQ 2. https://youtu.be/6cFMWWoAxlw The application fee is (JD 25) for each major, non-refundable.
How to find the results	The names of students admitted to the master's programs are announced on the official website of the University and the official university page on social networking sites (Facebook).
Required documents to apply	A copy of the certificate and the disclosure of high school marks. A copy of the certificate and disclosure of Bachelor's degrees from a recognized University. The system of university marks shall be indicated in it. It can be confirmed that the university issuing the Bachelor's degree is recognized in Jordan through the website of the Ministry of Higher Education: http://rce.mohe.gov.jo/en/RecognizedUniversities A copy of the civil status ID (for Jordanians) or passport. An updated version of the resume. A copy of experience certificates and training courses, if any.

A written consent issued by the authorized body stating that there is no objection to studying the holder for the members of the Jordanian Armed Forces and security agencies.

A copy of the proof of English language ability document: the applicant must have obtained the mark approved by the Ministry of higher education and scientific research in an English language exam and must not have been more than two years since the date of submitting the English language exam, as follows:

TOEFL iBT exam from the AMIDEAST Center.

IELTS exam from the British Council, Oval International Academy, or UniHouse-for consultations and studies.

The equivalent exam is from the German Jordanian University, Yarmouk University, the University of Jordan, the Hashemite University, or Mu'tah University. Additionally, the result of the equivalent exam should be approved by the Ministry of Higher Education, noting that (the holding of the equivalent exam was suspended by a decision of the Higher Education Council dated (20/10/2022)).
