-Applications will no longer be accepted or will no longer be looked into if they are received from other sources from the mentioned above after 29/9/2022 in addition to abiding to the enrollment and payment procedures.

### **Third: Required Documents for Applying**

1-A copy of high school certificate and grade transcript.

2- A copy of Bachelor and Masters Certificate Degrees and their grade transcripts from a recognized university.

To check if the university is recognized in Jordan, please use the following Ministry of Higher Education website:

3-A copy of the grading system for graduates from Non-Jordanian universities.

4- A copy of the national identification card (for Jordanians) or a passport copy.

5-An updated CV.

6-A copy of recommendations, working experience certificates, training courses if available.

7-An official written approval from the authorized party stating that they permit the applicant/student to continue his or her higher education, especially those affiliated to the Jordanian Armed Forces and Security Forces.

8-A copy of an e-payment receipt of the enrollment fees for each major (JDs25) or (\$40) non-refundable.

9- A copy of a TestDaf: Level-B2 valid for two years.

#### Documents required upon acceptance:

1- The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research shall set the average for graduates from foreign universities and those universities with no average.

2-A copy of the equivalence certificate from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research for graduates from Non-Jordanian universities.

#### Note:

- In case a student is accepted, he or she should bring copies of all the original paper documents.
- Completing the application form does not mean the student has been accepted since the student shall undergo a competition for the available seats as per the school's recommendation.
- The name of accepted students shall officially be announced after a thorough academic scrutiny is completed by the concerned school. Thereafter, an acceptance e-mail will be

sent to the accepted students and a rejection e-mail will be sent those students who were not accepted.

**Fourth: General Acceptance Conditions**

1. A Bachelor Degree with an average not less than good in German.
2. A Masters Degree with an average not less than good in German.
3. A Masters Thesis with an average not less than very good.
4. TestDaf Score **16** Certificate is a must.
5. Succeeding in the personal interview.
6. Attaching an English and German CV.

**Fifth: Additional Information:**

1. Courses of the first three semesters shall be taught at the German Jordanian University's campus in Jordan.
2. Courses of the following three semesters shall be taught in Freiburg University in Germany.
3. Accredited hour fees: JoDs 350 (\$500).
4. Number of program hours: 54 accredited hour.
