## **Bio:**

Before being appointed as the Vice President of the German Jordanian University in 2021, Prof. Malek Alsharairi has been the Dean of the [School of Management and Logistic Sciences](#) (SMLS) at GJU since 2017, during which he assumed different roles contributing to key institutional governance structures and committees at the university level.

Over the past 16 years in his academic career, he developed a solid perspective on international academia with a focus on Germany not only through the work on the German Accreditation and the Exchange Coordinator role, but also through participating in collaborative research with German colleagues (e.g. from [HTW Dresden](#) and [Europa-Universität Flensburg](#)), partnering in impactful funded projects by DAAD and GIZ and guest teaching at different German universities (e.g. in [TH Nürnberg](#), [HS Fulda](#), [HS Coburg](#) and [HTW Dresden](#)). Such engagement with the German higher education institutions enabled Alsharairi to enhance the German dimension and utilize it even during COVID crisis, as he could recently organize a digital summer school on entrepreneurship in Jordan jointly with German partners from [HTW Dresden](#).

The overall academic record of Alsharairi has been robust and outstanding as he won two scholarship grants to earn his master's and later his PhD from [Durham University](#) (ranked [82 on QS World University Ranking](#) and has a triple accreditation [AACSB, EQUIS and AMBA](#)). He received several honours and awards in academic and teaching excellence. Alsharairi supervises bachelor's and master's students (and one PhD student at University Hasselt in Belgium jointly with colleagues there). In terms of scientific research, he has more than 20 papers published in internationally peer reviewed journals, participated in more than 15 international scientific conferences and symposia, served as an external examiner to more than 30 master's theses, serves as a reviewer to a few journals and he was recently appointed on the editorial board of the top scientific journal in his field in Jordan ([JJBA](#)).

In terms of national and international community and professional service, he offered several training programs for accounting professionals and organized executive training programs for GJU administrators. He served in many National Accreditation Committees for [AQACHEI](#). In 2017, the Ministerial Council appointed Alsharairi to serve on the regulatory governmental commission for Public Accounting profession in Jordan. He is also a member of [JCPA](#) examination/licencing board. In 2021, he was appointed at the national [Recognition and Certificates Equivalency Committee](#) at the Ministry of Higher Education in Jordan.
