

Dr. Safa Nemeh Shweihat

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Biographical Summary:

Dr. Safa Shweihat is an Associate Professor in the Department of Fundamentals of Education at the German Jordanian University and the recipient of the Distinguished Faculty Member Appreciation Shield (2015–2016). Since 2023, she has served as Chair of the Educational Policies Committee at the Economic and Social Council in Jordan, contributing to national-level education reform and policy development. Her extensive professional experience includes serving as Advisor for Educational Development to the Prime Minister of Jordan during her sabbatical year (2017–2018). She received an American Fellowship in Civic Education in 2010 and held the position of Vice President and Chair of the Research Projects Committee at the Executive Office of UNESCO in Jordan from 2011 to 2013. From 2008 to 2009, she also served as Advisor to the Social Sciences Sector at the Higher Council for Science and Technology. Dr. Shweihat founded and directed the Department of Women's Studies and Projects at Isra University (2003–2005) and was an active member of the Advisory Board of the Catholic Center for Studies and Media from 2008 to 2023. A recognized authority in civic education, Dr. Shweihat has authored three academic publications adopted as instructional texts across various Jordanian universities between 2006 and 2023. Her doctoral research was instrumental in establishing National and Civic Education as a mandatory university requirement. She also developed the national project “Code of Civic Educational Conduct in Jordanian Schools.”

In the area of blended e-learning, Dr. Shweihat has been a pioneer since 2015, initiating one of Jordan's first major blended learning projects. Her work has been adopted at multiple institutions including the German Jordanian University, the University of Jordan, Isra University, the University of Luminos, and the Hashemite University. She has chaired numerous scientific committees, academic events, and conferences, and completed advanced training programs in the

United States, Germany, Italy, and Turkey. Her scholarly engagement spans national and regional conferences across the Arab world.

Dr. Shweihat is a member of the Arab Thought Forum, the International Organization for the Empowerment of Arab Women (since 2021), and the National Committee for the Development of the Civic Education Curriculum for higher education institutions in Jordan. She was also commissioned by the National Curriculum Center to evaluate the general frameworks of Jordanian school curricula in their draft and final forms.
