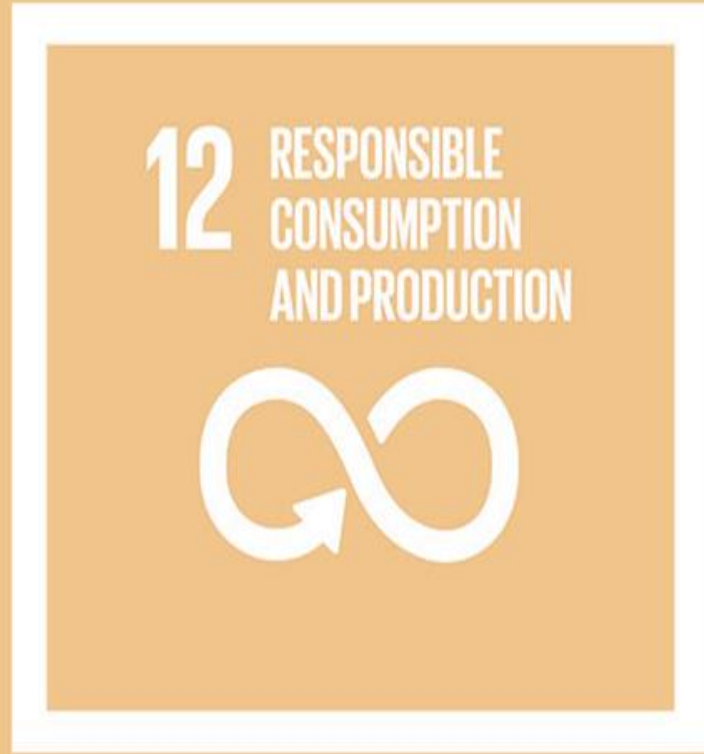

Sustainability in GJUs' Entities



In the Supply and Inventory Management Department (SIMD) we have been working on to promote sustainability and environmental responsibility within GJU. As a part of our ongoing commitment, SIMD taken steps to repair and repurpose old furniture within GJU.

Over the past 7 months, SIMD have identified pieces of furniture that were in disrepair or nearing the end of their lifecycle. Instead of disposing of these items, we started a project to restore and repair them.

The process involved refurbishing, repainting, and repairing damaged furniture to extend their usability and reduce the need for new furniture purchase.

The benefits of this initiative are twofold not only saving the cost associated with the new furniture, but we are also reducing the environmental impact. This project helps conserve resources, minimize waste, and aligns with GJU sustainability goals.
