- Admission interview.

- Portfolio that demonstrates projects undertaken during study and practice.
- C. V. illustrating the applicants' qualifications and experiences.

English Language Requirement:

A minimum TOEFL score of 80 out of 120 on an Internet based test (iBT), or a minimum IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 6.0. Students, however, can register as "Special Students" for one semester at GJU provided that they pass the test before the end of that semester.

- Official bachelor degree transcript and certificate (2 copies), stamped by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in Jordan
- Certified photocopy of passport
- Certified photocopy of personal identification card (ID) - for Jordanian students only
